

## Suranaree University of Technology Announcement On

## Preventive and Monitoring Measures in Response to the Coronavirus COVID-19 Outbreak

(Announcement No. 9)

Following the previous Suranaree University of Technology Announcement on Preventive and Monitoring Measures in Response to the Coronavirus COVID-19 Outbreak No. 8 which requests SUT students and staff to cancel or delay inter-provincial travel from and into Nakhon Ratchasima, and requires them to obtain a permission from the Rector before travelling if the trip cannot be cancelled or delayed and then to have the screening test after the trip and follow the preventive measures of SUT and other official bodies strictly, now it has appeared that the situation in Nakhon Ratchasima is getting better. Therefore, SUT would like to make another announcement on preventive measures against the new spread of COVID-19 that is suitable for the current improving situation, as follows:

- 1. SUT students and staff are still requested to cancel or delay interprovincial travel from Nakhon Ratchasima to the areas with maximum control designated by the Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) or by other agencies. In case that the travelling is necessary, an official written permission from the Rector must be obtained before travelling, and those students and staff must have the screening test after the trip and follow the preventive measures of SUT and other official bodies strictly after their return to SUT.
- 2. Travelling to the areas other than those with maximum control stated in Item 1 is possible, but that must be done by following the preventive measures of SUT and other official bodies strictly. This includes:
  - 2.1 If it is a personal trip, no permission from the university is required.
- 2.2 If it is a work trip assigned to you by SUT, a permission from the Head of the unit you belong to is required.

SUT thanks everyone and all the units in the university for their awareness and concern on this critical issue and for their cooperation in practicing these measures strictly. Your notification and report of COVID-19 suspected cases to SUT COVID-19 Surveillance Team and SUTH at 044-376555 will be greatly appreciated. Thank you for working together to keep our SUT free from COVID-19.
